



Chapter Flag

Chapter Flag Information

Each chapter is asked to create their own chapter flag. Flags are used to represent HOSA and your local chapter. The flag can be hand or commercially made. The flag should be oriented (or hung) on the side, on a standing flagpole not on the top as with a banner. Each chapter should have a stand. Label the stand with your chapters' name.

Chapter flag guidelines:

- Flag: 3' X 5'
- Pole: 8' X 1 1/4"
- Holder: 3-4 leg stand with screws.

Poles that can be unscrewed to be made smaller are the most convenient to transport. Flags should include your charter number and name of your chapter. The flag can also include a HOSA or school emblem. The flags can be HOSA or school colors.

The Opening Session will include a "Display of Flags" to recognize local chapters. You must bring a flag stand labeled with your chapter's name so that your flag can remain in the room throughout the Conference for everyone to see.

Chapters are encouraged to display award ribbons (e.g. Gold Star Chapter) on the top of the flag pole below the finial.
