

Regional Leadership Conference

- 1. Regional Leadership Conference 2021 Registration deadline is October 8, 2021.
- 2. The registration fee is \$30 per attendee with lunch included. The fees also help cover costs associated with the conference such as facilities, supplies, testing, awards, etc.
- 3. T-shirts are offered at an additional charge. More information will be posted on the NC HOSA website.
- 4. The online testing week will be October 25-29, 2021. Please identify proctors by October 8, 2021.
- 5. Competitors are allowed to compete in one event.
- 6. The number of competitors/teams per chapter per event at Regional Leadership Conference will be **Five (5)**. The exception is Health Career Display with only Three (3) teams per chapter allowed.
- 7. Middle school competitors do not have to place at regional events to compete at the state level; however, students are strongly encouraged to compete at the regional level for exposure to competitive events prior to State Leadership Conference.
- 8. Events for students who must be classified under the provision of the 2004 reauthorized Individuals with Disabilities Education ACT (IDEA) to participate are not restricted to number of students per chapter. Competitors in these events are not required to place at the regional level to compete at the state level; however, the competitors are strongly encouraged to compete at the regional level for exposure to the competitive event prior to State Leadership Conference. All IDEA events will be offered at RLC. IDEA events include the following:
 - Interviewing Skills
 - Speaking Skills
 - Life Support Skills
 - Personal Care



- 9. For the following events, secondary (high school) competitors must place in the top 5 to compete at State Leadership Conference:
 - Extemporaneous Writing (Students bring laptop)
 - Job Seeking Skills
 - Health Career Photography
 - Prepared Speaking
 - Researched Persuasive Writing & Speaking
 - Creative Problem Solving *
 - Health Career Display
 - HOSA Bowl *
 - * There will be an online test prior to the second round at district competitions.
- 10. For the following events, secondary (high school) competitors must place in the top 10 to compete at State Leadership Conference:
 - Medical Terminology
 - Medical Math
 - Human Growth and Development
 - Nutrition
 - Sports Medicine
 - Nursing Assisting
 - CPR/First Aid
 - Forensic Science
- 11. The <u>TEST</u> will be offered at RLC to provide more options/exposure to events for competitors. Students do not have to place in these events to compete at SLC.

For events highlighted orange on the CE posters (Nursing Assisting, HOSA Bowl, Creative Problem Solving, CPR), under the regional heading, attending the Regional Leadership Conference is required and each event will have a Round 2 at RLC. Nursing Assisting and CPR will have limited skill requirements for RLC and will then be responsible for all skill requirements at State Leadership Conference.
- 13. Health Career Photography is only required to have one picture for RLC. Competitors will be required to have three at State Leadership Conference.
- 14. Uploads to Tallo or Formstack are not required for Regional Leadership Conference.
- 15. At Regional Leadership Conference, competitor rating sheets will NOT be returned.
- 16. Every HOSA advisor who plans to participate in any regional activity should accept his/her fair share of regional management responsibilities. Every HOSA Advisor is asked to assist in the competitive events program.
- 17. All attendees (competitors, students, advisors, chaperones, etc.) must register and fill out the appropriate participation forms.
