NC HOSA State Leadership Conference (SLC) Checklist

Important Deadlines and Requirements:

- Conference Registration Deadline: February 15, 2024
 - Complete registration via the HOSA Apps Login.
 - All advisors, chaperones, and students must be registered.
 - NC HOSA requires a chaperone to student ration of 1 for every 10 students. Follow your school policy if it is stricter.
 - Every student that plans to compete must be registered for the competitive event.
 - Please include t-shirt size for all advisors, chaperones, and students that are registered.
 - Register Voting Delegates. Your chapter's number of voting delegates is based on chapter size and varies from 1-7. Number per chapter can be found on NC HOSA's WEBSITE under SLC 2024 – Voting Delegate Information.
 - Register for HOSA Happenings if your chapter participated. This can be found under the list of competitive events where students are registered. Information can be found HERE.
 - Register for NC HOSA Service Project if your chapter participated. Information can be found <u>HERE</u> under SLC 2024 NMDP HOSA Service Project. This is a chapter award, so money and hours need to be logged under one chapter member (any member is fine). The student will need to be registered for this event when you register for SLC (by February 15, 2024); however, the deadline for the service hours and money to be logged in to the HOSA Activity Tracking System <u>and approved</u> is February 22, 2024.
 - Register students for the Healthcare Issues Exam if you have competitors.
 - Register students for ATC tests if you have competitors. Remember, competitors may compete in unlimited ATC events at \$10 per exam.
 - Register students with volunteer service hours for the Barbara James Service Award. Be sure to register them for the Barbara James Service Award event at the time of registration; however, hours must be entered into the HOSA tracking System by the student and verified by the advisor and approved by February 22, 2024. Step by step instructions are in the guidelines found at BJSA.
- Gold Star Advisor Recognition Deadline: February 22, 2024
 - Requirements and forms are located on the NC HOSA website. Middle School forms can be found HERE and Secondary/PSC forms can be found HERE.

Gold Star Chapter Recognition – Deadline: February 22, 2024

NMDP (formerly Be the Match) – Deadline: February 22, 2024

- One student logs the hours or money raised by the chapter in the HOSA system. Student must be registered for this by the registration deadline of February 15, 2024. This is a chapter award, so it does not matter which student logs the hours. At SLC, only the chapter name will be called.
- The advisor must approve the hours in the HOSA system no later than February 22, 2024, for them to count.
- The NMDP Contribution Form is on SLC page of our **WEBSITE**.

Digital Uploads for Competitive Events – Deadline: February 22, 2024

- Information for Competitive Events that require a digital upload can be found on the NC HOSA Website. Secondary/PSC lists can be found <u>HERE</u>. Middle School lists can be found <u>HERE</u>. Uploads will be completed through the HOSA system.
- Instructions for uploading to the HOSA system can be found HERE.
- Events will be pre-judged prior to SLC.

Accommodation Forms – Deadline: February 22, 2024

- If a student needs accommodations at SLC, the form must be submitted via the NC HOSA SLC Accommodation LINK.
- HOSA's policies on accommodations can be found <u>HERE</u>.
- Examples of accommodations include but are not limited to a diabetic who needs a phone to monitor blood sugar levels and a presentation in which the student cannot stand, among others.
- This is a different form and process from the Eligibility Form for students who have an IEP.
- If these accommodations are not offered at SLC, they cannot be offered at ILC.

• Eligibility Forms – Deadline: February 22, 2024

- Eligibility forms are required for students who qualify under the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) and wish to participate in competitive events. These students must have an IEP. Students who have a 504 are <u>not</u> eligible for these evets. The eligibility form can be found on the NC HOSA Website <u>HERE</u>.
- The completed form must be submitted as an upload through the HOSA system.
- Events for students with an IEP are Life Support Skills, Personal Care, Speaking Skills, and Interviewing Skills.

State Officer Candidate Applications – Deadline: February 22, 2024

- Students are required to have teacher recommendation forms. Teacher recommendations must be submitted by the deadline through this <u>LINK</u>.

NC HOSA Awards – Deadline: February 22, 2024

- Annual awards are given for Honorary Life Member, VIP Award, Partnership Award, and Merit Award. Descriptions of each award can be found on the NC HOSA SLC <u>PAGE</u> under SLC 2024 – NC HOSA Awards.
- Advisors can nominate people for these awards.
- Nomination forms must be submitted by the deadline via this LINK.

National Anthem Singer/T-shirt Design/Pin Design – Deadline: February 22, 2024

- Students can submit audition videos to sing the National Anthem at opening sessions of SLC. Interested students may submit an audition video using this LINK.
- Students are invited to submit designs for the NC Pin and t-shirt to be used at the International Leadership Conference (ILC). Designs should be creative and not include dates. Design finalists will be voted on during the business session at SLC.
- Designs for the trading pin should be submitted via this LINK.
- Designs for the t-shirt should be submitted via this <u>LINK</u>.

- All conference attendees, including advisors, chaperones, students, and guests must complete a form.

- Make a copy of all your forms and place them in an envelope with your chapter name, advisor/chaperone name, and cell phone number. Turn in the envelope during onsite registration. Be sure to have the originals with you at the conference.

Dress Code

- In efforts to maintain a professional appearance, HOSA has a specific dress code for all genders. Students will wear official HOSA dress, including suit jacket, for opening, recognition, and awards ceremonies. Students will also wear official HOSA dress for competitive events unless otherwise specified in event guidelines.
- Students who are not in official HOSA dress will not be allowed admission to the above ceremonies and may incur a point deduction for competitive events.

Name Badge/Bracelet

- All attendees must wear the conference name badge and bracelet provided by NC HOSA during the entire conference. This includes competitive events, expos, and educational symposiums.
- Do not alter the name tag in any way.
