60+ points (Gold Star) Middle School Chapters

Chapter of the Year: Chapter of the Year is awarded to the chapter (in each division) with the highest number

of points, based on rubric score. Chapter of the Year will be recognized at NC HOSA State Leadership Conference. Please note if there are no submissions for a division then there will not be a Chapter of the Year for that division. Chapters shall be limited to no more than two consecutive terms, after which an individual must step down for at least one

full term before being eligible to serve again

Service Projects Other Service Projects include any projects that provide a service to others and are

related to healthcare.
